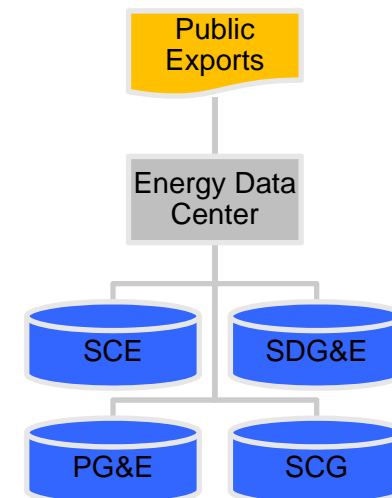



Benefits of an Energy Data Center

California Solar Statistics is the official public reporting site of the California Solar Initiative (CSI), presented jointly by the CSI Program Administrator and the California Public Utilities Commission. This site presents actual program data, exported from the CSI online application tool each Wednesday. Users of this site can view program data summaries for the CSI General Market, Multifamily Affordable Solar Housing (MASH), and Single-Family Affordable Solar Homes (SASH) programs provided in several figures and tables, and can also download the complete Working Data Set for their own analysis.

Get your hands on the data behind the figures and tables. Spreadsheets containing comprehensive information for the entire program are available here for download.

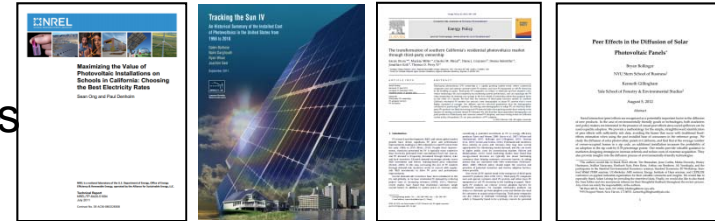

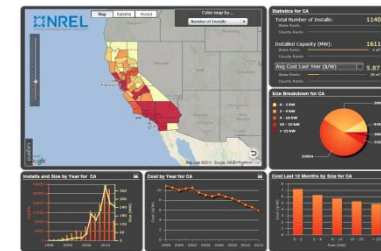

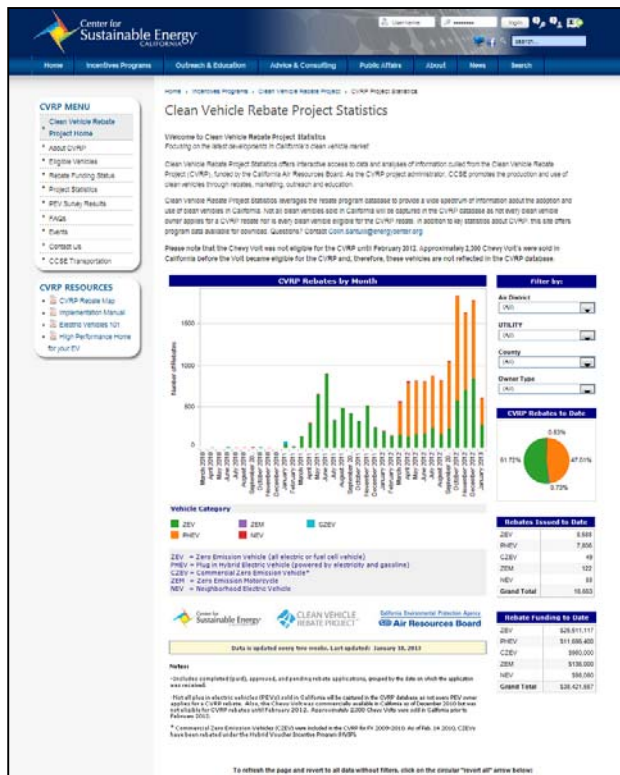
