## Damaged Ground Wire Molding

General Order 95, Rule 31.1, states in part:
Electrical supply and communication systems shall be designed, constructed, and maintained for their intended use ... to enable the furnishing of safe, proper, and adequate service.

GO 95, Rule 18-B, states in part:
If a company, while performing inspections of its facilities, discovers a safety hazard(s) on or near a communications facility or electric facility involving another company, the inspecting company shall notify the other company and/ facility owner of such safety hazard(s) no later than 10 business days after discovery. The notification shall be documented.

Poles numbered GT17310, 4741069E and 4863020E had broken third party communications cable lashing wires. TWC did not document the condition and notify the third party company of these GO violations when it last inspected the poles.
