

The units listed in the table are defined as "facility points" within PacifiCorp's inspection system. For overhead facilities, a facility point is a pole including all equipment installed on the pole. The span of wire between poles or service drops spanning from poles to customer's facilities are associated to the nearest facility point for inspection purposes. For underground facilities a facility point is the location associated with ground mounted equipment, including all equipment at that individual location such as a padmount transformer or switch cabinet.

\*Two overhead patrols listed as outstanding are under investigation and will be reported upon after investigation has been completed.
