

Notice of Intent to Adopt
a Mitigated Negative Declaration and
Notice of Informational Workshop
for the PG&E Embarcadero-Potrero 230 kV Transmission Project Application No. A.12-12-004

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) Energy Division has prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study (ISMND) for consideration of PG&E's application to construct the Embarcadero-Potrero Project, a new 3.5 mile transmission line from Embarcadero Substation near the corner of Fremont and Folsom Streets, to Potrero Switchyard on Illinois Street between 22nd and 23rd Streets. Approximately 2.5 miles of the route would be installed offshore underneath the seafloor of the San Francisco Bay. Based on this document, it has been determined that the proposed project, as modified, would not have any significant effects on the environment.
