<p>One project was identified within 2 miles of the planned Dibble Creek Workaround site: a planned Pacific Fiber Link/Worldwide Fiber ILA site, located approximately 1 mile west of the planned workaround site on Baker Road on a 1.46 acre site within parcel no. 24-030-06. Pacific/Worldwide's use permit application was filed in early May 1999 and will go before the planning commission in August.</p>	<p><i>City of Red Bluff: Lynn Oakley of the City Building Department Office (530) 527-2605</i></p> <p>No approved projects are within 2 miles of the workaround site. The only pending projects within 2 miles of the Dibble Creek Workaround are two planned residences located within the Highland Bluff Subdivision, approximately 0.25 miles southwest of the workaround site, near the intersection of Highland Bluff Drive and Rolling Hills Terrace. According to Ms. Oakley, the developer for these two lots may have lost interest in the development, as he has taken no action on the pending building permit applications for several months.</p>
