Ahart's paronychia (*Paronychia ahartii*) is a federal species of concern associated with valley and foothill grassland, vernal pools, and cismontane woodland.

The Palo Cedro ILA site does not contain appropriate habitat for Ahart's paronychia. Slender Orcutt grass (*Orcuttia tenuis*) is a federal threatened and state endangered vernal pool endemic plant.

The Palo Cedro ILA site does not contain appropriate habitat for slender Orcutt grass. Woolly meadowfoam (*Limnanthes floccosa* ssp. *floccosa*) is a CNPS list 2 plant. It occurs in vernally wet areas, ditches, and ponds.

The Palo Cedro ILA site does not contain appropriate habitat for woolly meadowfoam.
