

CEQA Guidelines (Section 15358) require discussion of potential indirect impacts of a Project. Indirect impacts are impacts caused by a project that occur later in time or are farther removed in distance, but are still reasonably foreseeable.

There are no substantial impacts that would occur later in time or that are removed at distance in the case of the Project to replace the SONGS 2 & 3 steam generators. Indirect impacts are actually direct impacts in that they occur directly as a result of a project, although the relationship between the cause and effect of the impact may be somewhat obscure for indirect impacts. The proposed SONGS 2 & 3 SGRP has only potential for minor, temporary indirect impacts, and these potential impacts have been considered in this document on a resource-by-resource basis. All project impacts, including indirect impacts that could occur in the future or at distance, are discussed within Sections 5 and 6.
