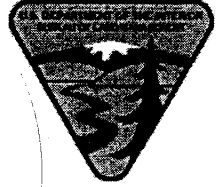

If the non-wires alternatives are eliminated for any reason, then the preferred ~~and~~ wires alternative is the TE/VS line in the Trabuco District of the Cleveland N.F. However, that project is already under consideration by FERC as a component of the LEAPS project. In addition there is a prior application for an SUP by EVMWD and TNHC which would pre-empt an application by SDGE+E. In essence this means that SDGE+E could not accomplish construction of TE/VS. What would CPUC do in that case? TNHC has applied to CPUC to build the line A0710005, but there is no guarantee that they will get a CPCN for the project. A bewildered public wants to know how in principle this can be all
