The draft EIR is an excellent discussion of the consequences of the various options to meet San Diego's future energy needs. The report's impact on your decision concerning SDG&E's proposed Sunrise Powerlink should be substantial. The Anza-Borrego route proposed by SDG&E ranks at the bottom of the various alternatives and should be rejected.

At a time when we are looking at ways to minimize the impact of energy use on our environment and promote the creation of modern, reliable and sustainable energy systems, SDG&E's Sunrise Powerlink proposal is out of date. We should be looking at ways to do away with overhead transmission lines, not build more.

The impact of a massive power line through the Anza-Borrego State Park would be substantial, detrimental and unacceptable. Please reject SDG&E's Sunrise Powerlink proposal in favor of alternatives that would have less impact on the environment and be more reliable, flexible, and sustainable.
