The lack of information makes me very nervous.

I believe that the least that can be done to someone you are about to force into a life changing event, is be honest and forthcoming. I would ask that the project be taken its original way, and if not, let us know what we are looking at so we can try and plan our lives. Just like SDG&E is checking their alternatives, I would also like to see what possibilities I may or may not have.
