This letter is written in opposition to the proposed Sunrise Powerlink to be built by SDG&E through Anza Borrego Desert State Park. While residents of San Diego County from 1971 through 2006 we visited Anza Borrego each year. The desert environment is fragile. The damage incurred in building this power line will take approximately 100 years to repair. The existing open space of Anza Borrego will be lost to the power line. Alternate routes, such as along Interstate 8, through areas that are already impacted by development should be used for this power line.
