Ms. Coronado:

Jurisdictional features were identified as part of the Preliminary Jurisdictional Determination. A revised Preliminary Jurisdictional Determination and Summary of Impacts to “waters of the United States” and “waters of the State” was submitted for review and approval on February 24, 2010. Impacts to jurisdictional features were considered during the original design of the project and have been further revised to avoid sensitive features to the extent feasible. Locations of upland pull sites were selected to avoid surface water, riparian areas, wetlands, and floodplains to the extent feasible. Structures were designed to avoid streambeds and drainage channels to the extent feasible. The locations of the structures are shown in the Project Modification Report Mapbook, which was submitted to the CPUC on May 14, 2010.
