Re: Resolution concerning the Recirculated DEIR/DEIS for the proposed Sunrise Powerlink.

Whereas:

1. The Sunrise Powerlink is unnecessary, expensive and the environmental damage cannot be mitigated, and
2. Because power lines can be easily damaged by high winds, fires, earthquakes or terrorism, the Sunrise Powerlink will be more unreliable than in-basin generation, and
3. In our fire prone area transmission lines hinder firefighting aircraft, and
4. The ugly, industrial appearance of the tall transmission towers of the Sunrise Powerlink will destroy our beautiful backcountry vistas, and
5. A permit has been filed for the wind farm at La Rumorosa but not a single windmill has been built - Mexican projects have a history of not being completed so it is premature to require the construction of the Sunrise Powerlink to carry non-existent energy, and
6. A much better solution to our energy needs would be in-basin natural gas generation and requiring roof top solar on all new construction.

Therefore:

The Potrero Community Planning Group opposes the Sunrise Powerlink in its entirety.
