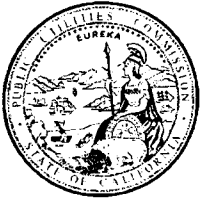
Question Email:\* How are the Energy Companies and the government <sup>achieving energy</sup> independence <sup>by this?</sup>

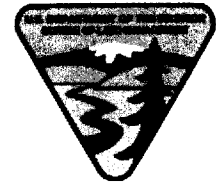
