The alpine blvd. option is an improvement over the original eir. It eliminates impact on Star valley road. The Star valley Road option indicates the power line going west south of the ridge has been moved about 1000 ft. south before it turns north to alpine blvd. This is an improvement if the top of the power poles are below the ridge because of low flying aircraft. The portion going north over the ridge connecting to the underground portion on star valley rd. makes the area look like an industrial site as discussed in the EIR. Star Valley rd. is a special natural and cultural site and members of the original settling family over 70 years ago, still live on the road. It is a home to hawks, golden eagles, deer, wildcats, pumas etc. The renowned Alpine Rock overlooks the valley next to the power towers.
