Elected Officials and Concerned Citizens:

I am opposed to the Modified Route D Alternative. We recently have attempted to parcel approximately 160 acres into 4 x 40 acres through the San Diego County Planning Commission. The acreage involved is part of the Modified Route D alternative (Assessor Parcel No. ((APN)) 6071002900). The County Planning Commission listed numerous provisions to be met in order to parcel, which included sequestering acreage to provide a wildlife corridor and migratory path for birds. We also have Oak Trees that have numerous raptor nests that should not be disturbed according to the planning commission. Also, we were told that we had to build a 6-foot brick wall and have an archeological dig with curator ship in a museum for rock outcroppings found to have Indian artifacts – these are in the proposed pathway of your Modified Route D Alternative.

It seems counter-intuitive to me that a 150-foot electrical tower would be less obtrusive then a single-story house to migrating wildlife. Also, we were told we have land that could not be built upon due to a possible flood plane issue.

A further concern to me is that the proposed "Pull Site" for the cable is within feet of our homes on the North side of Lake Morena Drive. The "Staging Site" located west of Lake Morena Drive encompasses approximately over 100 acres of my cattle grazing land. Losing this land to grazing due to storage of construction equipment and cable spools would essentially cause me to sell my cattle business and also cause great financial loss to me and my family.

It seems to me that allowing a Mega Watt Electrical Line/Towers to be built on my land, when we can't build a home, surpasses the level of hypocrisy to almost the level of criminal.

I therefore strongly oppose this Modified Route D Alternative through our community of Campo.
