Subject: Draft Environmental Impact Report for the Proposed Tri-Valley 2002 Capacity Increase Project

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has prepared the enclosed Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for consideration of Pacific Gas & Electric Company's (PG&E Co.) application to build and operate the Tri-Valley 2002 Electric Power Capacity Increase Project. This Proposed Project would increase electric service to the Tri-Valley area by adding substations in North Livermore and Dublin, expanding the Vineyard Substation in Pleasanton, and installing about 23.5 miles of 230 kilovolt (kV) transmission lines to serve these substations. The Draft EIR evaluates and describes the potential environmental impacts associated with the construction and operation of PG&E's Proposed Project, identifies those that could be significant and presents mitigation measures, which, if adopted by the CPUC or other responsible agencies, could avoid or minimize these impacts. The Draft EIR also evaluates alternatives to the Proposed Project that could eliminate or reduce some of these impacts, including the No Project Alternative, as required by CEQA.

The Draft EIR was released for public review on December 26, 2000. The 800+ page Draft EIR will be available for review at several area libraries and on the project website, as listed on page two of this notice. In order to help affected communities understand the proposed project and the Draft EIR, and to explain how the public can participate in the CPUC's decision-making processes, the CPUC will hold three informational meetings on January 23, 24, and 25, 2001. These informal meetings are an opportunity to speak with the specialists who wrote the Draft EIR and ask questions; the specialists will be available at any time between 6:30 and 8:30 p.m., on the dates and locations listed below. While written comments may be submitted during these informal meetings, there will be no facilities to record oral comments.

Three Public Participation Hearings will also be held, on February 8, 13, and 15, 2001, to receive oral and written comments from interested parties. A CPUC Administrative Law Judge will conduct the Public Participation Hearings on the Draft EIR, and comments will be entered into the public record.
