Dear Ms. Greenwood,

Various members of the consultant team hired by the CPUC for conduct environmental analysis for the proposed project visited the project area and took photographs as part of their reconnaissance of the area. Some of these photographs were taken to identify candidate locations for key viewpoint analysis, which included preparation of computer simulations showing what the views from these locations would be if the proposed project is approved. Not all candidate locations were chosen for key viewpoint analysis because there are such a large number of potential vantage points that could be analyzed. Instead, a more limited number of views were selected that were considered representative of the types of changes in visual conditions that would exist along the transmission corridor if the proposed project is built.
