**Rough Acres Ranch Right-of-Way Easement for Sunrise Powerlink**

1. The Draft EIR/EIS provides an alternative for the Tule Wind project that places the project's substation, operations and maintenance facility, and a portion of the 138 kV line on Rough Acres Ranch. Iberdrola raised a concern that this alternative is not feasible due to the timing of the Sunrise Powerlink construction and the temporary laydown area being used for the Sunrise project. Please provide information about the timing and schedule of the Sunrise project to identify any temporary or permanent easement restrictions associated with the construction and completion of Sunrise Powerlink Project.
