The Energy Division of the California Public Utility Commission (CPUC) has completed its review of Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E's) application, including the Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) dated December 28, 2017, and the subsequent responses to data requests for the Martin Substation Extension/Egbert Switching Station Project. The CPUC's Information and Criteria List and PEA Checklist were used as a basis for evaluating completeness and ensuring that the CPUC can complete environmental review of the proposed project as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on review of all information provided, CPUC finds that the PEA and subsequent data requests are sufficiently complete to enable CPUC to independently analyze the environmental effects of this project.

The CPUC and its consultant reserve the ability to ask further clarifying questions as the environmental review proceeds. PG&E's response will be important in providing an accurate analysis of the project for CEQA purposes.
