Dear Eric:

Central Valley Gas Storage, LLC (CVGS) is requesting the CPUC's issuance of a notice to proceed (NTP #6C) to install civil foundations, piping systems, and associated equipment at the compressor station. Please be aware that all of the work associated with NTP #6C will be done within the previously approved compressor station work area (approved as part of NTP #1). This work is scheduled to occur within the next several weeks.

To support compliance with APM GEO-3, we will be providing the design drawings for the compressor station via email. These drawings will show that the structures and facilities will be constructed in accordance with all applicable state and county building and construction codes and ordinances related to earthquake safety and structural stability during ground shaking for the above ground structures on the well pad site. Geotechnical borings were provided to you as part of the MMCRP #1 and NTP #1 submittals.

To support compliance with Mitigation Measure AIR-1, we are providing a letter from CH2M Hill (dated June 14, 2011) that provides the documentation that the compressor station auxiliary building is designed with energy saving features to meet the requirements of the California Title 24 Energy Code. The letter summarizes the energy saving features of the building for architectural, mechanical, and electrical systems.

CVGS has provided the relevant permits, plans, and supporting documentation as part of the Mitigation Monitoring Compliance and Reporting Plan submittals and NTP #1 (which included construction of the remote well pad and compressor station sites) to the CPUC and additional items to support this NTP request.
