Hi Rica,

During our February 16th conference call, we indicated that we would have the burrowing owl surveys completed and the data to the CPUC by the end of March. However, the peak breeding season for burrowing owl is stated in the protocol as April 15th. Conducting the surveys in March is allowable under the protocol, but not necessarily accurate especially for this area which may have a later spring due to higher elevation. Please let us know your preference for the timing of the surveys and we will schedule accordingly.

Per your request, below is a list of the dates the winter burrowing owl surveys were conducted and if any burrowing owls were observed.

Habitat assessment surveys

- January 11, 2010 - No burrowing owls observed
- January 12, 2010 - No burrowing owls observed

Burrow and burrowing owl surveys

- January 25, 2010 - One burrowing owl observed approximately 500 feet west of the East Count Substation site - (Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM) North America Datum (NAD) 1983, Zone 11, 0582176 Easting (E) and 3610426 Northing (N) (in meters)
- January 26, 2010 - One burrowing owl (likely the same burrowing owl observed on January 25) observed approximately 500 feet west of the East Count Substation site - UTM NAD 1983, Zone 11, 0582175 E and 3610387 N
- January 27, 2010 - No burrowing owls observed
- January 28, 2010 - No burrowing owls observed
