We have lived in the same home for 48 years. At one time there was natural gas being pumped from under our home for the benefit of many consumers. The fact that there was natural gas below our home did not worry or trouble us in any way.

On April 28, 2009 we attended a meeting of the California Public Utilities Commission on the Proposed Sacramento Natural Gas Storage Project and were surprised to hear so many negative comments and "what if's" concerning this project. They said they felt the area was selected only because the majority of the residents were people of color. However, we believe the area was selected because it already existed and previously held natural gas.

We think most people would agree that natural gas storage is important, but want it put in someone else's neighborhood, not theirs.

When we get in a car and go out on the highway, or board an airplane there is a certain amount of personal risk involved, but we take that risk because we feel the benefit is greater than the risk involved.

We ask that the Public Utilities Commission take a close look at this project and if they feel the safety factors are in place and the benefits to the public are greater than the risks that they would give it their consideration.

RE: EIR for the Sacramento Natural Gas Project

Mr. Rosauer,

We live in the affected area of the Sacramento Natural Gas Project and are concerned about the health and safety aspects of this project. The Environmental Impact Report (EIR) elaborates on several areas that indicate there are significant impacts to residents and property regarding the soil and the potential for gas migration and leaks. It seems that there is more than sufficient concern to not move forward with this project.

In addition to the health and safety concerns, there is a property value concern. The EIR does not address the property value impacts with regard to this project. That is a deficiency in the report. Homeowners are concerned that the real or perceived value of homes in the area will decline when potential buyers find out the house sits above a gas field in operation of pumping gas in and out and the transportation of gas.

Home values in El Dorado Hills fell sharply with the discovery of asbestos under their homes even though their children continue to play outside and they continue to drink the water. We feel there is a real potential for the same response and devaluation of homes if this project is constructed. With the economy the way it is, the natural gas project would just compound the decline in property value and cause a selling disadvantage for the area.
