DECLARATION: San Diego Gas & Electric Company's Tie-Line 649 Wood-to-

Steel Replacement Project

Pursuant to California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order 131-D, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) filed an application with the CPUC for a Permit to Construct (PTC) the Tie-Line (TL) 649 Wood-to-Steel Replacement Project (proposed project; Application A.15-08-006).

Project Background

SDG&E proposed to replace the existing wood poles supporting the power line with steel poles to increase fire safety and service reliability. The portion of the power line in which the existing poles would be replaced is approximately seven miles long and is extends through portions of the City of Chula Vista, the City of San Diego, and unincorporated San Diego County.

Construction is estimated to last approximately 10 months. SDG&E states that the proposed project would (1) increase the fire safety and service reliability of TL 649, and (2) locate proposed facilities within existing corridors to the extent feasible.

Information Available

The CPUC prepared a Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act to evaluate the potential environmental impacts associated with construction of the proposed project. The Draft IS/MND identifies those impacts that could be significant and presents mitigation measures which, if adopted by the CPUC, would avoid or minimize these impacts.
