The California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Energy Division CEQA Unit has conducted a completeness/deficiency review of the proposed Cabrillo – Santa Ynez Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) and Application (A. 09-07-010) that was filed on July 9, 2009. According to the requirements of the CPUC's Information and Criteria List, the CPUC Energy Division concludes that the PEA/Application is now complete.

While the PEA and Application are considered to be complete based on CPUC requirements, the environmental team may still require additional information from PG&E in order to prepare a complete and adequate CEQA document. The CPUC Energy Division will submit these needs in the form of data requests to PG&E during the course of the CEQA process. As a result of the process described above, the CPUC has found the PEA and Application for the Cabrillo-Santa Ynez to be complete and will initiate CEQA preparation.
