Gill Ranch Storage Company (GRS) submitted Application 08-07-032 and Pacific Gas and Electric submitted Application 08-07-033 for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for construction and operation of natural gas facilities. PG&E's Application also requests a Permit to Construct an electric substation and a 115kV electric power line. The Energy Division has completed its review of GRS and PG&E's application to construct the Gill Ranch natural gas storage facilities project. With the supplemental data and information provided by GRS and PG&E, the Energy Division finds that the Application and Proponent's Environmental Assessment contain sufficient information to satisfy the requirements of the Commission's Information and Criteria List and can now be deemed complete. Please note that this determination has been made with the understanding that the Energy Division may request additional data, as necessary, to review and analyze the environmental effects of the proposed project in accordance with requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.
