The California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Energy Division California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Unit has completed a deficiency review of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) Application (A.15-12-005) and Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) filed on December 3, 2016 for a Permit to Construct (PTC) the Fulton-Fitch Mountain Reconductoring Project.
