



Notice of a Public Informational Meeting for the Proposed PG&E Fulton-Fitch Mountain Reconductoring Project

Proposed Project: Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) filed an application (A.15-12-005) with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) on December 3, 2015, for a Permit to Construct (PTC) the Fulton-Fitch Mountain Reconductoring Project to reinforce the electric transmission system in

Sonoma County by replacing conductor for a 9.9-mile-long section of the Fulton-Hopland 60 kV Power Line in between Fulton Substation and Fitch Mountain Substation. The project would replace poles along 8.1 miles of the Fulton-Hopland 60 kV Power Line and replace conductor on 1.3 miles of the Geysers #12-Fulton 230 kV Transmission Line, and make modifications to Fitch Mountain Substation.

Public Meeting: The CPUC, as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), will hold an informational meeting for the public, to describe PG&E's proposed project and the CEQA process.
