The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has reviewed the request for Minor Project Modification #5 submitted by PG&E on October 4, 2012 for the approved Crazy Horse Switching Station Project (Project). This letter serves to notify you that the CPUC has approved Minor Project Modification #5.

Approval of Minor Project Modification #5 includes the extended use of a previously approved temporary logging road as part of Minor Project Modification #3 (approved on August 16, 2012), as well as use of the road for all other construction activities. In addition, the modification approves temporary stabilization of the temporary logging road and a segment of the permanent access road with base rock and geotextile fabric, as well as permanent stabilization of an existing ranching access road segment with gravel.
