**QUESTION 4**

How does PG&E ensure that its natural gas transmission pipelines are aerial patrolled by competent aerial personnel familiar with PG&E's patrolling procedures, continuing surveillance procedures, and class location procedures?

**ANSWER 4**

PG&E utilizes its Operator Qualification (OQ) program to ensure competency of aerial personnel and their familiarity with PG&E's patrolling procedures (OQ 08-01 and 08-02, see response to GTSCClassLocationOII\_DR\_CPSD\_009-005). These OQ requirements cover the tasks required for patrol.
