

Pilot Observations

1. **Land slides** or threatened slides.
2. **Erosion** by streams, wave action, rain, etc.
3. **Land subsidence** that could affect the pipeline or main.
4. **Construction or maintenance work** being done by others along the pipeline (extends at least 220 yds. on either side) or encroachments on the right-of-way.
5. Evidence of **gas leakage**, as indicated by vegetation, bubbles in surface water, etc.
6. Signs of severe **seismic displacement** (fault zones).
7. **Damage to facilities** owned by company.
8. **Damage to highway structures and other facilities** not owned by company where public safety is a factor.
9. **Presence of survey parties** or other indications of possible future work that **extends at least 220 yards on either side of pipeline**.
10. Report any evidence of **atmospheric corrosion** on above ground piping.
11. **Access roads** that may not be in a passable condition.
12. **Any other factors affecting the operation or safety**.
