In the matter of the application of Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, for approval of a certain contract entered into between it and the Southern Pacific Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company, corporations, for the construction, maintenance and operation of a bridge over the Santa Ana River at El Moro Station, Orange County, California, on petitioner's Newport Beach Line, and to use in common with petitioner approximately 3000 feet of the said line and the exclusive use of connecting tracks in said vicinity.

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company having applied to the Commission for authority to execute and carry out a contract attached to the application and marked Exhibit "A" for the construction, maintenance and operation of a bridge over the Santa Ana River at El Moro Station, Orange County, it appearing that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and it further appearing that this application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Pacific Electric Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to execute and carry out the contract attached to the application and marked Exhibit "A" under the following condition and not otherwise:

(1) Applicant shall not urge before this Commission the use of the valuations or rentals set forth in said Exhibit "A" for any other purpose than that covered by this application.
