Western Pacific Railroad Company having applied to the Commission for permission to lease certain tracks and other facilities in or near the Town of Marysville, Yuba County, said tracks and facilities consisting principally of trackage and bridge across the Yuba River and particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached to the application and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permission be and it is hereby granted Western Pacific Railroad Company to lease certain property in or near the Town of Marysville, Yuba County, as described in and under the terms set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein under the following condition and not otherwise:

(1) Applicant shall not urge before this Commission the use of the valuations or rentals set forth in said Exhibit "A" for any other purpose than that covered by this application.
