IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that paragraph 2 of Decision No. 6836 reading as follows:

The San Diego Electric Railway Company is ordered to set aside and pay into a separate depreciation fund monthly the sum of \$18,000. All earnings of the fund from whatever source and to whatever amount shall be added to the depreciation fund.
This depreciation reserve fund shall be held and accounted for under the direction of, and shall not
be used without the authority of, this Commission.
The Company is ordered to work out and submit to
the Commission within 60 days of the date of this
Order such rules for the accounting for and use
of this fund as will embody the desires and recommendations of the applicant in this matter. Such
rules shall not become effective until approved by
the Commission.

be and it is hereby amended and altered to read as follows, to wit:

San Diego Electric Railway Company is ordered to set aside and pay into a separate depreciation fund monthly an amount in cash equal to one-twelfth of the total annual depreciation as shown in annual depreciation schedule as filed annually with the Commission. This depreciation reserve fund shall be held and accounted for in accordance with. "Rules Governing Depreciation Fund", heretofore or here-

after approved by this Commission and shall not be used without the authority of this Commission.
