ORDER

L. S. Neighbors and W. Bauer, co-partners, have filed a joint application with E. E. Rugg in which they petition for an order authorizing the co-partnership to sell and Rugg to purchase a certain automobile stage line operated between Willits and Hearst, California.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was obtained by the co-partners under Decision No. 5799 in Application No. 4088, dated September 26, 1918 and authorizes the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Willits and Hearst and intermediate points, Mendocino County, California.

No consideration is involved in the present transfer. We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1.

1. Applicants Neighbors and Bauer, co-partners shall immediately cancel all tariff of rates and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 of the Railroad Commission.

2. Applicant E. E. Rugg shall immediately file, in duplicate, in his own name, tariff of rates and time schedules, or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules as filed by applicants Neighbors and Bauer. All tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicants Neighbors and Bauer.

3. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Rugg herein unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
