IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Condition "2" of the order in Decision No. 7L29, dated February 13, 1920, reading --

"When all or any part of the notes herein authorized are paid, all or a proper proportion of the bonds pledged as collateral shall be returned to applicant's treasury and thereafter issued by applicant only as authorized by the Commission."

be, and it is hereby, amended so as to read --

Upon the payment of the \$2,500,000.00 of three -year six per cent. notes, applicant may deposit with the trustee under its proposed mortgage securing the payment of the bonds authorized by Decision No. 11467, dated January 6, 1923, \$2,500,000.00 of its general mortgage four per cent. bonds deposited as collateral to secure the payment of said \$2,500,000.00 of notes. The remainder of the general mortgage four per cent. bonds deposited as collateral to secure the payment of such notes shall upon the payment of such notes be returned to applicant's treasury and

thereafter issued by applicant only
as authorized by the Commission.
