SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in its Decision No. 7778 in Application No. 5662 dated June 16th, 1920, the Railroad Commission authorized Rochester Oil Company to temporarily discontinue gas service in the cities of Fairfield and Suisun, Solano County, California, by reason of the failure of its natural gas supply, and

WHEREAS, Rochester Oil Company has since that time made without success, diligent effort to discover additional sources of natural gas, and

WHEREAS, Rochester Oil Company through its qualified officers now makes application for an order of the Railroad Commission granting it permission to permanently discontinue gas service in the cities of Fairfield and Suisun, and to settle its affairs and dispose of its property.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, good cause appearing, that Rochester Oil Company be, and is hereby authorized to permanently discontinue gas service in all the territory served by it, and to withdraw from public service.
