WHEREAS, Condition No. 3 of the Order therein contained provided that the rights and privileges granted applicant Frank Beanier could not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned without the written consent of the Railroad Commission, and

WHEREAS, under date of March 23, 1923, said Frank Beanier, in a written communication addressed to the Railroad Commission, stated that he has not operated automotive truck
