TWENTY-NINTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

SANTA CRUZ COUNTY UTILITIES

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second paragraph of the Order of October 14, 1923, in the above entitled proceeding be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1. The time within which Santa Cruz County Utilities shall reconstruct its existing system so as to comply completely with the provisions of Chapter 499, laws of 1911, as amended by Chapter 600, laws of 1915, is hereby extended to and including May 1, 1923."

In all other respects the Order of October 14, 1923, in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
