BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 11855, dated March 30, 1923, authorized MANTECA TELEPHONE COMPANY to issue \$38,500.00 of stock and not exceeding \$8,000.00 of notes; and

WHEREAS, the authority of the Commission was subject, among others, to the condition that the note should not be delivered until the Commission by supplemental order authorized the execution of a mortgage securing its payment; and

WHEREAS, the company has now advised the Commission that it has decided to execute a deed of trust securing the payment of its note and has filed with the Commission on April 18, 1923, a copy of its proposed deed of trust; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed deed of trust is in satisfactory form; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that MANTECA TELEPHONE COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to execute a deed of trust substantially in the same form as that filed in the above entitled matter on April 18, 1923, to secure the payment of a promissory note which the Commission

authorized to be issued by Decision No. 11855, dated March 30, 1923, provided that the authority herein given to execute a deed of trust is for the purpose of this proceeding only and is granted only in so far as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act and is not intended as an approval of such deed of trust as to such other legal requirements to which said deed of trust may be subject.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 11855, dated March 30, 1923, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
