SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 7999, dated August 23, 1920, M. L. Booth was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between California Redwood Park and Boulder Creek and intermediate points.

Under date of April 27, 1923, said Booth filed a written request with the Railroad Commission in which he asks for an order authorizing him to discontinue service as he is unable to continue owing to ill health.
