O R D E R

Richard Morrissey, Jr., has filed an application with the Railroad Commission in which he petitions for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Merced Falls and Hornitos and intermediate points, California.

Applicant claims in his petition that there is at the present time no service by public carrier between the points he proposes to serve; that a public necessity exists for such service which he proposes to meet through the operation of a Ford truck having a freight capacity of one-half ton and a passenger capacity of two in addition to the driver. He proposes to render one round trip per day, charging a passenger rate of \$1.00, each way, between Merced Falls and Hornitos and a freight rate of 25 cents per 100 pounds.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Richard Morrissey, Jr., of an automotive stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Merced Falls and Hornitos and intermediate points, California, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

Applicant shall file his written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed ten (10) days from date hereof; shall file, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules, identical with those as filed as Exhibit "A" and "B" attached to the application herein, within a period of not to exceed twenty (20) days from date hereof; and shall commence operation of the service herein authorized within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof.

The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

No vehicle may be operated by applicant herein unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
