C. C. White, owner of the C. C. White Water Company, a public utility, supplying water for domestic purposes to residents in and in the vicinity of Chico, Butte County, and more particularly described in the form of deed attached to the application herein and marked Exhibit "A", having made application for authority to transfer the above named water system to W. E. White and for authority to change the name thereof to the W. E. White Water Company, and W. E. White having joined in the application and having agreed to take over all obligations of service now rendered by the C. C. White Water Company, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HERREN ORDERED that the above application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That W. E. White proceed diligently with the installation of the storage facilities ordered in this Commission's Decisions No. 9726, dated November 8, 1921, No. 10695, dated July 11, 1922, and No. 10998, dated September 18, 1922, and complete the installation thereof within a

ressonable time, but in no event later than July 15, 1923;

- 2. That the authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before July 31.
 1923, and a certified copy of the final instrument of convoyance shall be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
- on which c. c. White actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, a certified statement shall be filed with this Commission indicating the date on which such control and possession was actually relinquished.
- 4. That the consideration given for the transfer of this public utility property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
