SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 10469, dated May 17, 1922,
the Railroad Commission granted Wm. Allen a certificate of
public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation
of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers
and express between Santa Maria and Sisquoc.

Condition No. 2 of the order therein provided
that service under said certificate could not be discontinued
without written authorization of the Railroad Commission. It
now appears from communication received on May 7, 1923, from
the attorney for applicant, that service was discontinued
several months after the issuance of said certificate, no
authorization having been obtained from the Railroad Commission
to that effect, nor was the Commission informed that applicant
had discontinued service until request was made upon him to
file annual report in accordance with the rules and regulations

of the Commission.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 10469 in the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
