In the Matter of the Application of CHARLES MUELLER AND R. A. BAKER, for an order authorizing the transfer of the CHIHUAHUITA WATER SYSTEM in the County of Los Angeles.

Charles Mueller having made application to this Commission for authority to transfer to R. A. Baker a certain public utility water system supplying consumers in the County of Los Angeles, and commonly known as the Chihuahuita Water System, and the said R. A. Baker having joined in the application, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Charles Mueller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to R. A. Baker a certain public utility water system in the County of Los Angeles, commonly known as the Chihuahuita Water System, and generally described in the application herein, upon the following conditions:

1. - The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before October 1, 1923, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by the said Charles Mueller within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. - Within ten (10) days from the date on which the said Charles Mueller actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which

such control and possession was re-
linquished.

3. - The consideration given for the transfer of this water system shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
