FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It having been brought to the attention of this Commission that subsequent to the making of our order No. 12166 in the above-entitled case, directing defendants to discontinue the operation of automobile stages for the carriage of passengers for compensation as described in said order, and finding that such operation was in violation of law, the said defendants, or certain of them, have operated in violation of said order and of law,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Secretary of this Commission be and he is hereby directed formally to request the District Attorneys of the counties within which such operation is included to institute such action or actions or proceeding or proceedings as may be necessary in order to require and obtain compliance with the law, and to punish violations thereof.
