SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under date of February 5, 1920, the Commission issued its Decision No. 7075 in which decision M. W. Bacon, doing business under the fictitious name of Kings River Stage and Transportation Company, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an auto-motive truck line as a common carrier of freight between Sanger and Fresno and intermediate points.

Said M. W. Bacon has failed to file tariff of rates covering the service authorized under the certificate hereinabove mentioned and upon his attention being called to such failure stated that he did not desire to operate under said certificate due to the fact that after the issuance thereof the service of existing carrier had been improved to the extent that the establishment of service by him was not warranted at the time.
