FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

The Railroad Commission by Decision No. 10651, dated July 1, 1922, authorized CONSOLIDATED WATER COMPANY OF POMONA to issue not exceeding \$30,000.00 of its two-year eight per cent. notes and to use \$24,035.50 of the proceeds to pay for the construction of extensions, additions and betterments. The order provides that the remainder of the proceeds may be expended only for such purposes as the Commission might authorize in supplemental orders.

Applicant reports that additions and betterments, amounting to \$21,400.00 and referred to in Decision No. 10651 have been finished and paid for, but none of the notes have been issued. Applicant is at present engaged in constructing two cement reservoirs, -one of a capacity of 1,500,000 gallons and the other of 500,000 gallons, costing \$15,650 and \$6,800 respectively. It is also engaged in laying two miles of 14 and 16 inch steel mains from Orange Grove Avenue to the new 1,500,000 gallon reservoir and 2000 feet of 4-inch cement pipes leading from such reservoir to its present well No. 3. It is thought that the cost of the reservoirs and the cost of such new pipes together with the additional pipe which it is planned to lay this year will cost approximately \$50,000.

The company asks the Commission to modify its former order so as to permit it to deliver \$20,000.00 of the notes authorized by said order to pay in part for the cost of the acquisition and construction of the extensions, additions and betterments referred to in this

supplemental order.

The Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes that it should be granted as herein provided, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 10651, dated July 1, 1922, be, and it is hereby, modified so as to permit the CONSOLIDATED WATER COMPANY OF POMONA to issue and deliver not exceeding \$20,000.00 of the notes authorized by the order in said decision for the purpose of obtaining funds to finance in part the cost of the extensions, additions and betterments referred to herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 10651, dated July 1, 1922, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
