EIGHTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

MIDLAND COUNTIES PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION, having reported to the Railroad Commission that during the month of May, 1923, it expended for extensions, additions and betterments to its plants and properties, the sum of \$20,267.25, and having requested permission to use the proceeds from the sale of \$11,896.32 of the bonds which the Commission authorized to be issued and sold by Decision Number 11038 dated September 29, 1922, to finance in part the cost of these extensions, additions and betterments which are described in the statement of expenditures against estimates for the month of May, 1923, which is on file with the Railroad Commission, and the Railroad Commission having considered applicant's request and being of the opinion that it should be granted, as herein provided,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that MIDLAND COUNTIES PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION be, and it is hereby, authorized to use the proceeds from the sale of \$11,896.32 of the bonds authorized by Decision Number 11038 dated September 29, 1922, as amended, to finance in part such construction expenditures referred to herein as are properly chargeable to capital ac-

count, as defined by the Uniform Classification of Accounts prescribed or adopted by the Railroad Commission.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 11038 dated September 29, 1922, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Eighth Supplemental Order.
