In the matter of the application of Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, for permission to construct and maintain at grade tracks across certain public highways in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, on applicant's Albambra-San Gabriel Line, in connection with the construction of its proposed rail-road from a point in its present rail-road line in the City of San Gabriel, now constructed to San Gabriel Boulevard and running thence in a general easterly and northeasterly direction to approximately Golden West Avenue in the said County of Los Angeles.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company applicant herein having on July 2, 1923 filed a petition in the above entitled proceeding asking for a modification of the Commission's Decision No. 12275, dated June 26, 1923 in the above entitled matter to the extent of permitting grades of approach of five and five-tenths (5.5) per cent at the crossings of certain streets authorized in said decision and it appearing to the Commission that such modification should be made,

IT IS HETTEY ORDERED, that condition No. 2 of Decision No. 12275, dated June 26, 1923, in the above entitled matter be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(2) Said crossings of San Gabriel Boulevard, Fifth Street. First Street, Vista Street, Orange Avenue, Muscatel Avenue, Rosemead Avenue, Manzanitta Avenue, Sunset Boulevard and San Gabriel Avenue shall be constructed of a width and type of construction to conform to those portions of said streets now graded with top os rails flush with pavement at the respective points of crossing; shall be protected by suitable crossing signs, and shall in every way be made safe for the passage theroover of vehicles and other road traffic. Said crossing of San Gabriel Boulevard shall be constructed with grades of approach not exceeding two (2) per cent; said crossings of Fifth Street, First Street, Vista Street, Orange Avenue, Muscatel Avenue, Rosemead Avenue, Manzanitta Avemue, Sunset Boulevard and San Gabriel Avenue shall be constructed with grades of approach not exceeding five and five-tenths (5.5) per cent. Said crossings of Sixth Street. Encinita Avenue and Live Oak Avenue shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding five and five-tenths (5.5) per cent will be feasible in the event that the construction of a roadway along said Sixth Street. Encinita Avenue or Live Oak Avenue shall hereafter be authorized and so that said crossings may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic."

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 11275 dated June 26. 1923 shall remain in full force and effect.
